There is a 4,000 character limit (including spaces and the bibliography). Each case report is required to begin with an abstract, limited to 35 words (present tense), describing the uniqueness of the case that merits presen-tation at the Grand Rounds. The below case report fields will be available within the submission form as separate text boxes. Image uploads are not permitted.
